#### **Issues**

Every community needs a support system for people to turn to in urgent situations; one that addresses their most immediate and critical needs.



#### **Solution**

We fund programs that address urgent gaps in the areas of food, housing, utility assistance, language support, child care, and information and referral services.



### **Results**

**934,166 meals** served.

**55,032 people** received help with housing or utilities.

**37,739 people** received information and referrals to human service organizations.

**1,172 people** received language support services.

**1,622 people** received legal representation or crisis intervention for sexual assault victims.
