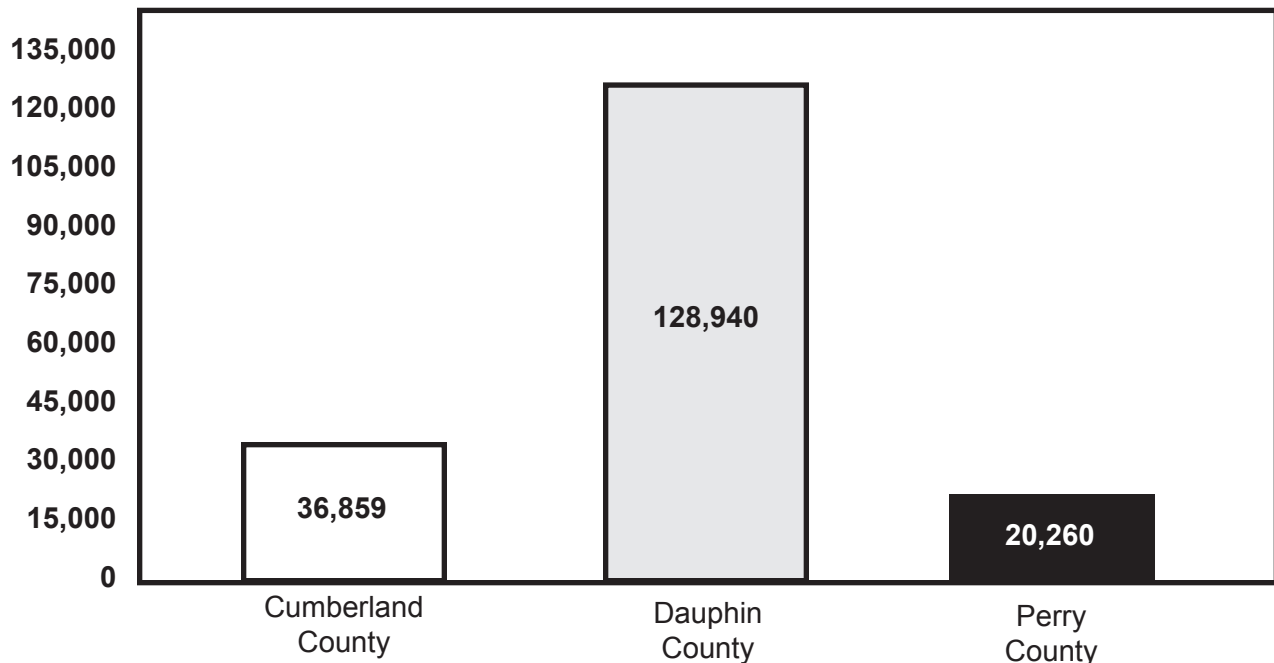

UNITED WAY OF THE CAPITAL REGION HELPS LOCAL PEOPLE

Services provided by United Way of the Capital Region's program partner agencies help residents throughout the Capital Region. From April 2016 to March 2017, United Way provided financial support to 37 program partner agencies that provided 65 programs. A total of 186,059 people in the Capital Region utilized services provided by a United Way-funded program during that time.

A total of 36,859 of these people resided in Cumberland County; 128,940 in Dauphin County; and 20,260 in Perry County. This significant representation across the three counties proves United Way supports a wide range of important community services that are used throughout the Capital Region.
