## VOLUNTEERS NEEDED TO HELP WORKING FAMILIES WITH TAX PREPARATION

HARRISBURG – (September 19, 2018) – Volunteers are needed to offer free tax preparation to help working families receive the federal and state tax credits they are eligible for. No previous experience is required and training is provided.

In tax year 2017, 238 volunteers provided free income tax preparation for low- to moderate-income families as part of the Money in Your Pocket (MIYP) campaign, a community collaboration of organizations committed to the economic stability of local families. Nationally the effort is known as the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance program, or VITA. Volunteers filed 4,721 tax returns, resulting in more than \$4.4 million returned to local families. The average annual income for clients receiving tax preparation services was \$21,227 and the average return was \$1,218.

The Money in Your Pocket campaign received financial support from the PNC Foundation and the U.S. Department of Treasury, Internal Revenue Service.

Volunteers will offer tax preparation services at designated sites in the Capital Region from January 28 through April 15, 2019 during day and evening hours. All volunteers will be trained to prepare computerized, electronic returns.
